SALZBURGER ALMENWEG TRAIL

An unforgettable hiking experience over 350 km. On the Salzburger Almenweg trail, you're sure to leave your everyday life behind down in the valley. It is one of the most beautiful long-distance hiking trails in the Alps and leads through the Pongau mountains to over 120 alpine pastures - 2 of the stages lead through Wagrain-Kleinarl. An overview map & brochure with detailed descriptions of the 25 stages can be obtained free of charge from the Wagrain-Kleinarl Tourist Office and online at <u>www.salzburger-almenweg.at</u>.



SALZBURGER SPORTWELT HIKING BUS

Just show your Wagrain-Kleinarl Sportwelt Card and you can travel on the hiking bus for € 1,00 per person/journey (until 31.10.). Valid for routes to St. Johann im Pongau/Alpendorf, Flachau, Wagrain-Kleinarl, Radstadt, Altenmarkt-Zauchensee, Eben, Filzmoos, Grossarl/Hüttschlag, Forstau and as far as Obertauern. Just state your final destination to make use of the € 1,00 ticket even if you change buses.

HIKING PASS

Keen hikers will find stamps for their hiking pass at many alpine huts as well as on peaks in Wagrain-Kleinarl. Show your hiking pass with the stamps collected at the Tourist Offices in Wagrain-Kleinarl and you'll be rewarded with a hiking pin (1 hiking pin per person/stay free of charge with the wagrain-kleinarl guest card). Pick up your free hiking pass from the Tourist Office.



NEW - Digital hiking pins

Collecting hiking pins in Wagrain-Kleinarl is now also possible with your smartphone!

How does the digital pin work?

Download the SummitLynx App (in the APP Store or in GOOGLE PLAY) to make entries in the virtual summit and/or tour book including photos and text and automatically collect points for the hiking pins. Keep a record of your alpine achievements online and prove to your friends that you have reached your goal. As soon as you have collected enough points for the hiking pin, you will receive a notification and you can pick up your souvenir as usual at the Tourist Offices in Wagrain and Kleinarl.





SALZBURGER SUMMIT GAME

At the Tourist Offices as well as at various accommodations in the Salzburger Sportwelt region you can purchase your personal summit box. It contains the basic equipment with a tour book, a drinking cup incl. carabiner and a hiking map. Then it's off to climb the summits (walk at the bottom of the Bischofsmütze, Hochgründeck (p.26), Penkkopf (p.27), Saukarfunktel (p.24), Lackenkogel, Rossbrand, Gerzkopf) in any order you wish. Stamp your tour book at each summit. Incidentally, there is no time limit. You can, for example, start this summer and complete the game next summer. The summit game can even be played over several "years".

For every stamp in your book, we will then give you a "collection summit" for your drinking cup. In the summit books, you will find interesting information about the mountain and a ritual. Let them inspire you. Once you have climbed at least four of the seven peaks, a cool surprise awaits you at one of the tourist offices.

10 RULES of conduct for handling grazing livestock

- 1 Please **avoid contact** and do not feed them
- 2. Keep calm, do not scare grazing cattle!

3. Mother cows protect their calves, avoid contact between mother cows and dogs!

4. Keep dogs always under control and keep them on a short leash. If an attack by grazing cattle is about to happen: Put them on a leash at once!

5. Do not leave hiking trails on alpine pastures and meadows

6. If grazing cattle block the path, **keep** as much **distance** as possible.

7. When grazing cattle approach: Stay calm, do not turn your back, avoid the animals.

Leave the grazing area quickly at the first sign of 8. excitement

9. **Observe fences.** If there is a gate, use it and then close it properly and cross the pasture quickly.

10. The alpine pastures are wonderful nature experiences. If everyone obeys the rules and shows respect, nothing stands in the way of this recreational fun.

WIMMWEG -STEINEGGWEG

Kleinarl

Starting right in the centre of Kleinarl - at the Cafe-Restaurant Olympia 9 − you set off towards the Jägersee Lake. Past the Wiesenweg and the Wimmsiedlung you finally turn left at the dirt road. and take the next turning to the left, and follow the path as far as the Steineggweg. Via the Stuhlweg path back to the Kreuzsalgasse. Past the Kleinarl Parish Church, you finally return back to the starting point - the Cafe-Restaurant Olympia.

③ 1 hour√ 156 m altitude diff.

SCHWAIGHOF TRAIL

No. 2 | Wagrain

Start in the centre of Wagrain (Café Bosek) and head alongside the Schwaighofbach stream to the Schwaighof district. Back you either go the same way or you take the hiking bus.

 \bigcirc 2 hours \checkmark 168 m altitude diff.

VILLAGE TOUR

No. 1 | Kleinarl

Start at the Kleinarl Tourist Office: along the road towards the church, turn right at the vicarage, cross the wooden footbridge, and turn off right again along the cycle path to the Ployergraben bridge. Continue left along the gravel path below the Peilsteinpalfen to the adventure playground, along the Kesselfallbach river to the car park at the entrance to the village. Along the pavement towards Kleinarl as far as the Viehhofstrasse junction, from there to the chapel and finally past the forester's house and back into the village.

S 1 hour, ✓ 107 m altitude diff.

FÜRBACH CIRCULAR ROUTE

No. 1+5 | Wagrain

From the Grafenbergbahn cable car valley station via the hiking trail Kleinarl (no.1) alongside the stream to the Unterspannberg continue via the Fürbachweg (No. 5) to the Kirchboden and back to Wagrain or vice versa.

KESSELFALL CIRCULAR HIKING TRAIL

No. 80 | Kleinarl

Starting from the Peilsteingasse in Kleinarl, along the cycle & footpath turn right at the bridge, along the Hirschleiten estate road to the Kesselfall turn-off. The descent leads through the Kesselfall below the Adventure Land, above the Peilsteinhof farm into the village.

③ 1,5 hours✓ 201 m altitude diff.



AROUNDTHE JÄGERSEE LAKE

No. 1 | Kleinarl

The tranquil Jägersee Lake and the idyllic landscape that surrounds it, makes the circular walk a time to "clear" your head of any "thoughts". The best way to get to Jägersee Lake is by bus, but it is also possible to drive to the end of the valley and park there. After your head is "emptied", it is definitely worth stopping for refreshment at the Jägersee Gasthaus ?

WAGRAINER ALM (ARZKENDL)

No. 56 | Wagrain

Drive by car 2.5 km in the direction of Flachau. Turn left at Bergweg (in front of Sampl Stove Setters – large, tiled stove) and follow the road as far as the Wagrainer Alm car park. From there it's a max. 30-minutes walk to the Wagrainer Alm.

BAUERNSTÜBERL VIA KLEINARLTRAIL

No. 1 | Kleinarl

From the valley station of the Grafenbergbahn cable car along the Kleinarler Ache to the Bauernstüberl bus stop. Cross the bridge and turn off left to the Bauernstüberl. 🖓

S 2 hours✓ 149 m altitude diff.

GASTHAUS PRÖLL

No. 77 | Kleinarl

Starting from the Kleinarl Church along the Kreuzsalgasse and Stuhlweg to the Gasthaus Pröll ?? . (Refreshment stop in the evenings or with advance booking possible)

③ 1,75 hours✓ 226 m altitude diff.



JAUSENSTATION GRUB

No. 51 | Wagrain

Z

Turn left at the pharmacy up the Sonnseite access road, then follow the road slightly uphill to the Vordertiefenbach Farm. At the following two junctions (Tiefenbachgraben) turn left and continue towards Ginau to the Jausenstation Grub ? . Trail no. 51 leads on into the Ginau Valley to the Oberlehengut Farm (additional 45 minutes).

① 2,5 hours \checkmark 239 m altitude diff.

OLD ÖBRIST PATH

No. 54 | Wagrain

Via the Sonnseite estate road, climb up to the bridge over the Tiefenbachgraben. Then turn right and head along the old mule track (trail no. 54) via the Röcksbergbauer Farm to the Öbristbauer Farm. There are several options for the descent.

AROUNDTHE ÖBRISTKÖPFL / WAGRAINER ALM

No. 55 + 453 | Wagrain

By car along the Öbrist access road (junction from the main road 2 km heading towards Flachau / Moos signpost) to the car park. From there take trail no. 453 (Hochgründeckweg) to the Lackenkapelle chapel, turn left (no. 55) and around the Öbristköpfl back to the starting point or the other way round, to the Öbristbauer Farm, via trail no. 55 to the Lackenkapelle chapel. turn right (refreshment stop Wagrainer Alm $\frac{1}{2}$), heading towards Wagrain and trail no. 453 back to the starting point.

MÖNCHSBERG TRAIL

No. 74 | Kleinarl

Starting at the valley station of the Champion Shuttle chairlift, turn right at the Viehhofbauer Farm, slightly uphill to below the Mönchsberg chapel. Along the Brandstattweg access road back into the valley. Connecting trail no. 1 into the village.

③ 2 hours✓ 192 m altitude diff.

SCHÜTTBACH TRAIL

No. 59 | Wagrain

From the Moadörfl district along the Zollweg access road uphill to the Oberkendlbauer Farm. Turn right and follow the flat access road. After approx. 500 m turn right at the crossroads (no. 59) to the Unterschüttbauer Farm and along the hiking trail no. 2 back to Moadörfl.

GRAFENBERG -STARCHENSTADL - WAGRAIN

No. 713 | Wagrain

From the Grafenberg cable car mountain station along the hiking path no. 713 to the Starchenstadl and further along the hiking trail to the valley station of the Grafenberg cable car.

 \bigcirc 3,5 hours \swarrow 640 m altitude diff.

KLEINARL – WEISSENHOFALM

No. 77/85 | Kleinarl

Starting from the Kleinarl Church along the Kreuzsalgasse to the Stuhlweg, from there turn left along the hiking trail to the Berggasthof Pröll ??, then on to the Gasthaus Galler ??, then along the hiking trail to the Moosalm. From there the last stretch to the Weissenhofalm ??. Alternative ascent on the Champion Shuttle chairlift to the middle station.

() 4,5 hours \checkmark 770 m altitude diff.

STEINKARALM -KLEINARL

No. 714 | Kleinarl

Starting from the centre of Kleinarl, past the Jausenstation Ennskraxn the path crosses open pastures. The trail then leads through a high forest in steeper sections to the forest border. From here you reach the Steinkaralm ?? . Easy ascent on the Champion Shuttle chairlift - Moosalm - Weissenhofalm ?? - Steinkaralm - descent to Kleinarl.

 \bigcirc 4,5 hours \swarrow 686 m altitude diff.

KURZEGGALM

No. 712/81 | Kleinarl

The trail begins at the Kleinarl Tourist Office. Walk approx. 100 m in the direction of the Jägersee Lake, first over the covered wooden bridge and then right along the hiking trail. Further on there is another bridge, where you turn left. Then follow the Hirschleiten access road to the turn-off to the Kleinarler Hütte. From there take the slight ascent (forest road) towards the Kleinarler Hütte 12 , until the junction of the path to the Kurzeggalm .

 \bigcirc 4,5 hours \checkmark 711 m altitude diff.

TÄUBLWALDSTRAßE – HOCHSTEINWEG

No. 78 | Kleinarl

Starting from Jägersee Lake (bus stop) approx. 200 m along the main road towards Kleinarl. After the bridge on the right follow the Täublwaldstraße (No.78). After 3 km you reach the junction Hochsteinweg. From there you can descend via Hochstein back to Kleinarl.

LÄRCHENWALDWEG - EDELWEISS ALM - MARIAS SONNEN-QUARTIER

No. 61 | Wagrain

Start in the centre of Wagrain via trail no. 5, past the herb garden and the Kneipp course to the junction Weberlandl further uphill and after the second bend turn left into the second road, ascend via path no. 61 and continue to the Edelweiss-Alm ? . Return via Maria's Sonnenquartier and along the Mühlenweg back to Wagrain.

KLEINARL -GASTHAUS GALLER

No. 78 | Kleinarl

Starting at the Tourist Office in Kleinarl turn right into the Emmiweg, walk along the path and past the valley station of the Champion Shuttle chairlift to the Viehhofbauer Farm. There turn right into trail no. 74. Now follow the Mönchsbergweg to the Stuhlwaldstraße forest road - Lumberjack valley station. From there take the access road to the Gasthaus Galler 12 Return back via Berggasthaus Pröll 12 to the village of Kleinarl.

 \bigcirc 3,5 hours \checkmark 419 m altitude diff.

KASERLEHENWEG

No. 69 | Wagrain

Along the Grafenbergweg after the crossroads to the Strahlehenbauer Farm. turn left and follow path no. 69 across a grazing pasture. Continue along a tractor track to the Kaserlehen Farm and through the forest via a steep path to the forest road, and further downhill (no. 68) to the Jausenstation Krapfenbauer, 📌 then along the hiking trail (no. 713) downhill to the valley station of the Grafenberg cable car.

WAGRAIN -MOADÖRFL -EDELWEISS-ALM

No. 2/2a/60 | Wagrain

From Wagrain (centre) to the Schwaighof district and then on to Moadörfl. From the valley station of the "Rote 8er" cable car via path no. 60 to the Edelweiss-Alm ? and through the larch forest trail no. 61 back to Wagrain. You can also drive by car to the cable car valley station, from there walking time approx. 1 hour to the Edelweiss-Alm.

BAIERWALDSTRAßE

No. 71 | Kleinarl

Starting from the Brandstattweg (in Kleinarl) to the Stuhlwaldstrasse turn-off. Head along to the second fork in the road. There you turn left into the Baierwaldstrasse and walk along this to the Flying Mozart middle station. From there continue along the Wolfensbergweg (downhill) to Wagrain. Return journey on the hiking bus back to Kleinarl.

 \bigcirc 4,5 hours \checkmark 459 m altitude diff.

ÖBRISTWALDSTRAßE – SAUWALDSTRAßE

No. 73+74 | Kleinarl

Starting from the centre of Kleinarl, the path leads along the cycle and hiking trail in the direction of Jägersee Lake. After approx. 2 km turn right into the Öbristwaldstrasse. After several bends the road leads to the ascent to the Kleinarler Hütte 12 . From here it's possible to descend down to Kleinarl along the marked path or continue via the Sauwaldstrasse to the Mitterauweg and via hiking trail no. 1 back to Kleinarl.

SONNTAGSKOGEL (1.849 M)

No. 712+713 | Wagrain

From the Grafenberg cable car mountain station, the trail to the Sonntagskogel first passes the Grossunterbergalm \ref{lim} . As soon as you meet trail no. 712, you follow it to the left to the Sonntagskogel. The return route leads via trail no. 713, past the Hachaualm \ref{lim} , either back to the Grafenberg cable car mountain station, or you can descend via trail no. 713 to Wagrain (approx. 1.5 hours longer).

Route 2

Maurachalm & Auhofalm

The circular tour can also be extended by continuing to the Maurachalm ?? and the Auhofalm. Afterwards around the Grindkogel back to the Grafenberg cable car mountain station.

GRIEßENKARECK (1.991 m)

No. 714 | Wagrain

Route 1

Grießenkareck

From the Kirchboden along the Wolfensbergweg to the "Flying Mozart" middle station (access road), continue along a relatively steep forest trail no. 714 to the Wagrainer Haus 🖽 and on to the summit of the Grießenkareck.

○ 5,5 hours ✓ 1.118 m altitude diff.

Route 3

High alpine trail Grießenkareck -Weissenhofalm -Steinkaralm - Kleinarl

From the "Flying Mozart" mountain station ascent to the Grießenkareck along the mountain ridge trail (No. 714) or via the Bettlersteig (No. 714a) to the Ahornkarkopf, via Wildbühel and Weissenhofalm 12 on further to the Steinkaralm 12 . Descent to Kleinarl and return to the "Flying Mozart" valley station on the hiking bus (shortened route via Schüttalm 12 – descent to Kleinarl)

 \bigcirc 5,5 hours (to Kleinarl) \checkmark 412 m altitude diff.

Route 2

Summit hike via the Jandlalm

On the "Flying Mozart" cable car (or on foot + 469 m ascent) to the middle station. Continue via path no. 714 for half an hour, turn left, via trail no. 64 to the Jandlalm 😤 or the Grießenkaralmen 😤 , to the Kogelalm 🏖 and on to the Grießenkareck.

③ 3 Stunden ✓ 684 m altitude diff.





From the Flying Mozart cable car mountain station directly to the Grießenkareck and over the mountain ridge to the Saukarfunktel 2,028 m (Salzburg summit game - the poet). Then on to the Ahornkarsattel and finally via the Bettlersteig / Wagrainer Haus ? back to the starting point (mountain station Flying Mozart).

 \bigcirc 3,5 hours \checkmark 351 m altitude diff.





HOCHGRÜNDECK - THE HEALER (1.827 m)



No. 453 | Wagrain

Starting point Wagrain centre, by car towards Flachau, in the district of Moos turn left into the Öbristweg, approx. 3 km uphill to the last bend (car park), from there turn right to the Lackenkapelle chapel, take the path (no. 453) and continue to the Ginauer saddle, then a steep climb to the summit (No. 453) and further on to the Heinrich-Kiener-Haus ?? . Return = same as ascent. Another option via Ginau: by car, turn left at the pharmacy, continue past the Jausenstation Grub ?? , start at the car park Ginau. The Musician's Trail starts here up to the Hochgründeck / Heinrich Kiener Haus. ??

 \bigcirc 6 hours \swarrow 594 m altitude diff.



St. Vincent's Chapel of Peace



The Chapel of Peace was built in 2003. It is located between the Heinrich Kiener Haus and the summit of the Hochgründeck and is a popular spot for mountain masses, weddings, anniversaries and baptisms!

GABEL - WAGRAIN'S HIGHEST MOUNTAIN (2.037 m)

PENKKOPF - THE MAGICIAN (2.011 m)



No. 712 | Kleinarl

The trail begins at the Kleinarl Tourist Office. Now walk approx. 100 m towards Jägersee Lake and then over the covered wooden bridge to the right along the hiking trail. You will then come to another bridge, where you branch off to the left. Now follow the Hirschleiten access road until you reach the fork for the Kleinarler Hütte ?&. From there on you hike for approx. 2 hours along the forest path to the Kleinarler Hütte. From here you can reach the Penkkopf in approx. 45 min. along an easy path. The way back leads via the Kurzeggalm ?& until you meet up with the ascent path again.

 \bigcirc 5,5 hours \checkmark 1.006 m altitude diff.





ENNSKRAXN (2.410 m)

No. 714/90 | Kleinarl

Starting point Kleinarl centre past the church along the Kreuzalgasse, Steineggweg via the forest hiking trail to the Steinkaralm 2 , then up to the right to the forest ridge. Along this ridge, you reach the "Blaue See" (Blue Lake) on the steep rock face of the Ennskraxn. The trail leads along this rock face; until you reach the northwest ridge. Over the ridge to the summit cross (mountain experience, sure-footedness, head for heights an absolute must).

 \bigcirc 9 hours \nearrow 1.410 m altitude diff.

The name...

... "Ennskraxn" probably comes from the fact, that the source of the Enns river lies below. And "Kraxn" is derived from the colloquial "kraxeln", which means to climb.



RUPERTISEE LAKE

Wagrain

During a sporty excursion to the Rupertisee Lake, vou can dip vour feet into the pleasantly refreshing, artificially created reservoir. You can enjoy the mountain panorama of the Radstädter and Hohe Tauern ranges - what a great holiday feeling in Wagrain-Kleinarl! From the Flying Mozart cable car mountain station, you can walk 30-45 minutes to the nearby Rupertisee Lake (located below the Almstadl!).

 \bigcirc 3 hours \swarrow 409 m altitude diff.

DAARMOOSSEE & NIEDERBERGSEE LAKE

No. 61/60 | Wagrain

The Daarmoossee Lake and the Niederbergsee Lake can both be reached via the Weberlandl district (path no. 61 / Lärchenwaldweg trail) as well as via the Moadörfl / valley station "Rote 8er" (closed in summer) - trail no. 60.

S hours✓ 359 m altitude diff.

Note

NONE of these lakes are bathing lakes! Swimming is prohibited due to nature conservation.

FROM WAGRAIN TO THE JÄGERSEE LAKE

No. 1 | Wagrain - Kleinarl

The hiking trail to Kleinarl begins at the Grafenberg cable car valley station and leads alongside the Kleinarler Ache on the valley floor to the Jägersee Lake. At the Gasthof Jägersee ? there is the possibility to hike around the lake.

③ 3 - 3,5 hours
 ✓ 275 m altitude diff.

BLAUER SEE (BLUE LAKE)

No. 714 | Kleinarl

The smallest mountain lake in Wagrain-Kleinarl the Blue Lake - lies just below the Kleinarl local mountain, the Ennskraxn. Surrounded by rock faces, the lake got its name from its deep blue shimmering water. The starting point for the hike is the centre of Kleinarl, continue along the Steineggweg (behind the church) and via the forest hiking trail to the Steinkaralm 🍄 , then up to the right to the forest ridge. The "Blaue See" can be reached along this ridge on the steep rock face of the Ennskraxn.

 \bigcirc 6 hours \checkmark 900 m altitude diff.



"TWO LAKES IN ONE GO" JÄGERSEE LAKE & TAPPENKARSEE LAKE



No. 722 | Kleinarl

You can start the hike to the Tappenkarsee either from the Jägersee (plus 2 hour walking time) or you can continue by car along the left bank of the Jägersee and drive along the toll road to the Schwabalm car park. From here the well-signposted trail leads through the forest, in part somewhat steep, in many bends past a waterfall up to the Tappenkarsee. You can stop for refreshment at the Tappenkarseealm \Re or you can hike a bit further to the Tappenkarsee Hütte \Re .

 \bigcirc 4 hours \swarrow 680 m altitude diff.









FEEL-GOODTRAILS Wagrain

Getting close to nature is the focus of the two feel-good trails. The herb garden is the starting point for one of the two feel-good trails. The path meanders along the Schwaighofbach stream (towards the centre/ market). At the end of the trail, you'll find a cosy resting area.

The second feel-good trail leads from the Grafenbergbahn cable car valley station along the Kleinarler Ache to a resting area. Accompanied by the gushing of the stream, enjoy the gentle walk along this short, flat path. Two bridges entice you to stop and be enchanted by the power of the mountain stream. The feel-good paths in Wagrain are wheelchairs and stroller accessible.

① 1 hour



Access to the nature trail is at the end of the Kreuzsalgasse – Stuhlweg (400m from the Kleinarl Church). The starting point is at the Steineggweg junction by the panoramic info board. Along the family-friendly "Power of the Trees" nature trail. you'll find information regarding the elemental and healing power of 32 local deciduous and coniferous trees.

GREEN PATHS IN THE VALLEY

Kleinarl

The trails in Kleinarl can be started from anywhere. For example, you can start at the car park at the entrance to Kleinarl, and walk in the direction of the torrent dam, then hike further along the Kesselfall (through the high ropes course) - and on to the Ployergasse crossroads - now follow the forest road until you reach the next junction in the direction of the village centre. The path / signposting now leads down into the valley, where you finally turn left and walk along the edge of the forest (past the Abenteuerland) back to the starting point.

① 1,5 hours √ 189 m altitude diff.

Wagrain

Access to the "Green Trails in the Valley" in Wagrain is possible everywhere. A popular starting point is the herb garden in the centre of Wagrain. The path leads past the petrol station, through the district of Hof to Moos and further/return through the district of Lehenriedl, along Ölschlagerweg and Egg you eventually come to the "Flying Mozart" valley station. If you follow the signs, you will reach the valley again via the Fürbachweg and Unterspannberg and finally walk back along the foot of the Grafenberg back to the centre of Wagrain or the starting point.

MEETING THROUGH MOVEMENT

Burghügel Wagrain

The Burghügel (Castle Hill) above Wagrain, is a beautiful, quiet spot that entices you to linger. Between the remains of the old castle ruins there is an outdoor fitness park for all ages with different stations. From the municipal car park in Wagrain, the outdoor fitness park on Castle Hill can be reached in about 15 minutes on foot. From the car park go to the church, turn right and then follow the Museumsgasse (always keeping to the right) uphill to Castle Hill.

No. 51 | Wagrain

At the pharmacy turn left onto the Sonnseite access road, and follow this slightly uphill to the Vordertiefenbach Farm, at the next two forks (Tiefenbachgraben) turn left and continue towards Ginau to the Jausenstation Grub ?? . Trail no. 51 leads on into the farthest Ginautal Valley to the Oberlehengut Farm (additional 45 min.).

WAGRAINER ALM (ARZKENDL)

No. 56 | Wagrain

From the sports ground in Kleinarl follow the cycle and hiking path along the Kleinarler Ache to the Jägersee lake. From the Jägersee back to Kleinarl, it's best to take the hiking bus.

You start at the Champion Shuttle chairlift mountain station with the adventurous circular hiking trail. The 2.5 km long trail leads over 11 fun slides through the mountain meadows, past the funny "crazy Dolls" to the organic mountain restaurant Lumberjack % , where a stop for a bite to eat is certainly worthwhile. Now you can either go back through the forest with low ropes and climbing areas to the Champion Shuttle chairlift mountain station (another stop at the Gasthof Galler 🍄) and take the lift down to the valley or you can hike - from the organic mountain restaurant Lumberjack - via the forest road back to the valley.
